Prior Learning Bentonville Public Schools

NorthWest Arkansas Community College (NWACC) and Bentonville Schools enter into this partnership to provide opportunities for students to receive prior learning credit toward a Technical Certificate in Bicycle Assembly and Repair and an Associate of Applied Science in General Technology degree.

Students taking specified course work through Bentonville Public Schools can request prior learning credit from the appropriate division dean.

PROGRAM DESIGN

- A. NWACC will only accept 30 hours of prior learning toward an associate degree which requires 60 hours. Only fifty percent (50%) of certificate requirements can be from prior learning.
- B. Students must complete 15 credit hours of coursework at NWACC to earn an associate degree and 25% of the credit hours required for a certificate program.
- C. NWACC will award prior learning credit for Bentonville Public School's Gateway Program courses upon successful completion with a grade of C or higher for the following courses
 - Successful completion of Bentonville Public School's Gateway Program's Bicycle Technician and Project Bike Tech Programs will receive credit for BIKE 1003 and BIKE 1013
